Welcome / Call to Order

The meeting began at approximately 1:00 p.m. Technical Committee Vice Chair, Marilyn Toppins called the joint meeting of the Executive Board and Technical Committee to order.

Determination of Quorum / Roll Call

Quorums were present for both the Technical Committee and Executive Board. The roll call was waived.

Approval of June 29, 2022, Technical Committee Meeting Minutes

Vice Chairman Toppins asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the June 29, 2022, Technical Committee Meeting. David Lietzke made a motion to approve the minutes and seconded by Joe Miller. Members of the Technical Committee approved the minutes.

Approval of June 29, 2022, Executive Board Meeting Minutes

Mayor Frank asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the June 29, 2022, Executive Board Meeting. Brian Langley made a motion to approve the minutes and seconded by Joe Brooks. Members of the Executive Board approved the minutes.

Election of New Executive Board Chairperson

Mayor Frank asked for nominations to elect new Chairperson of Executive Board. Mike Byrd moved to nominate Joe Brooks as Chairperson which was seconded by Brian Langley and approved unanimously.

Discussion of the Project Ranking Procedure

Don Brown discussed the process to be used in ranking the projects and the two options available for the prioritizations process to either adopt the previous rankings or agree to alternative rankings which could then be voted on. Mr. Brown also discussed the project Criteria Weight and the information on the "NRPO Project Ranking List November 15, 2022" with these documents also provided in the meeting folders. Mr. Brown explained what a "committed" project entailed and how over time projects work their way up the list. He also explained that "previously funded projects" were being funded and moving towards toward the construction phase.

TDOT Presentation of the List of Prioritization and Projects to be Ranked

Randy Busler with TDOT noted that when working with railroad rights-of-way that have zoning influence, a letter to the mayor's office for a signature would be needed to proceed with a project.

Dexter Justis, Director of TDOT's Region 1 Project Development, discussed the process of how projects were ranked historically and the number of years until construction. Fiscal year 2024 will begin a new 3-year program. Mr. Justis went over each of the projects on the "NRPO Project Ranking List November 15, 2022". Mr. Justice discussed each project description, the status, and the project readiness to move to the next phase.

Technical Committee Vote on Project Ranking

After discussion, a motion was made by Joe Miller and seconded by David Lietzke to adopt the project ranking shown on the column "POTENTIAL November 15, 2022, Ranking Based on Previous Rankings" on the presented "NRPO Project Ranking List November 15, 2022". After further discussion, Joe Brooks recommended that the projects be ranked as shown in the column "Revised Nov. 2022 Ranking" on the attached "NRPO Project Ranking List November 15, 2022, Revised 12/8/22". David Lietzke amended his

original motion and moved that Joe Brooks recommended list be adopted. The motion as amended was seconded by Joe Brooks and then approved by the Technical Committee.

Executive Board Vote on Project Ranking

A motion was made by Mike Byrd and seconded by Mark Keck to adopt the same project ranking adopted by the Technical Committee. The motion passed. The adopted ranking is shown on the attached.

Presentation of "New Start" Projects

Don Brown provided information on "New Start" projects which are projects not budgeted for engineering, right-of-way or construction. Two potential new start projects include the 1. Widening of SR 33 from Mountain Rd. to First Ave. in New Tazewell, Claiborne County and 2. Addressing deficiencies including horizontal and vertical alignment and shoulder width on SR 29/US 27 from SR 62 in Wartburg to SR 329 in Sunbright, Morgan County. A vote would be needed.

Technical Committee Vote & Endorsement of New Starts

David Lietzke moved to rank the Claiborne County project as number 1 and the Morgan County project as number 2 and recommend them as new starts. The motion was seconded by Joe Miller and the motion passed.

Executive Board Vote & Endorsement of New Starts

Joe Brooks moved to adopt the same ranking and recommendation as approved by the Technical Committee which was seconded by Mark Keck. The motion passed.

Coordinator's Report

Don Brown provided the RPO Coordinators report including and noted addition of introduced Laura Smith as new staff member at ETDD.
